I majored in art all through school and upon graduation attended the Cleveland School of Art in Cleveland, Ohio. I continue to participate in private classes and workshops.

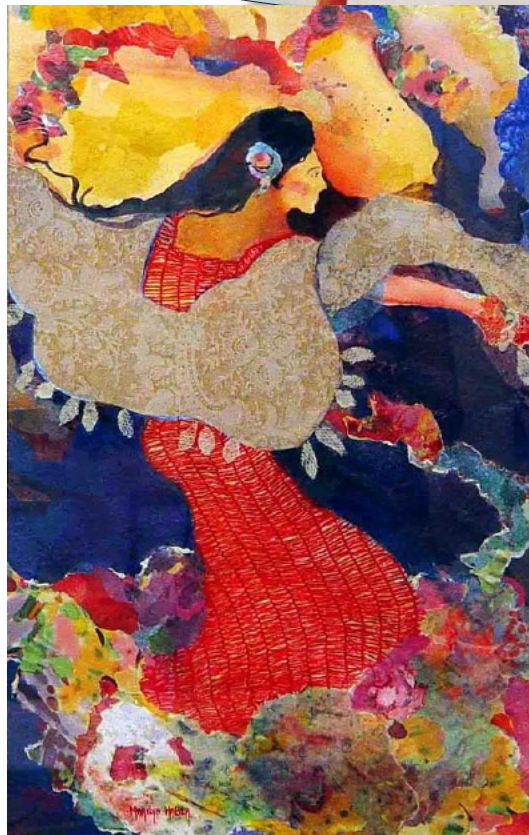
My first medium was watercolor – then to oils – then back to my first love – watercolor. I continue to experiment in this very exciting medium.
